Information for processing of personal data collected

In compliance with the provisions of EU Reg. 2016/679 (European Regulation for the protection of personal data) we provide the necessary information regarding the processing of personal data provided. The information is not valid for other websites that may be consulted via links on our site.

This is an information that is provided pursuant to art. 13 of EU Reg. 2016/679 (European Regulation for the protection of personal data) and is also inspired by the provisions of Directive 2002/58 / EC, as updated by Directive 2009/136 / EC, regarding Cookies and envisaged by the Provision of the Authority for the protection of personal data of 08.05.2014 on cookies.

1. SUBJECTS OF THE TREATMENT

2. PURPOSE AND LICENSE OF THE TRACTING

The personal data provided, Name, Surname, address, email will be processed in compliance with the conditions of lawfulness pursuant to art. 6 EU Reg. 2016/679 for the following purposes:

1. a) Management of inherent data processing (Article 6 letter b):

- navigation on this website;
 - filling out the forms for the collection of data for order management, send a request for a quote, and to manage any returns of goods.
 - fulfillment of contractual obligations, of law and administrative purpose
- table like for example issuing of invoices, arrangement of payments etc. For the purposes of the application of the provisions regarding the protection of personal data, the processing performed for administrative-accounting purposes are those related to the performance of organizational, administrative, financial and accounting activities, regardless of the nature of the data processed.

1. b) Management of data processing inherent (art.6 letter a):

- prior consent and up to your objection to receive, through automated e-mail, commercial newsletters, promotions, informative material and initiatives of the Data Controller. The owner to compare and possibly improve the results of communications, uses systems for sending newsletters and promotional communications with reports.

Thanks to the reports, the Data Controller will be able to know, for example: the number of readers, openings, unique "clickers" and clicks; the devices and operating systems used to read the communication; the detail on the activity of individual users; the details of the emails sent, e-mails delivered or not, of those forwarded; All these data are used for the purpose of comparing, and possibly improving, the results of communications.

3. ADDRESSEES OR CATEGORIES OF DATA ADDRESSEES

The personal data provided may be disclosed to recipients, named ex art. 28 of EU Reg. 2016/679, which will process data as managers and / or as natural persons acting under the authority of the Data Controller and the Data Processor, in order to comply with related contracts or purposes. Precisely, the data may be disclosed to recipients belonging to the following categories:

4. TRANSFER DATA TO A THIRD COUNTRY AND / OR AN INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION

The personal data provided **will not be transferred** abroad within or outside the European Union.

5. PERIOD OF CONSERVATION OR CRITERIA

The processing will be carried out in an automated and / or manual way, with methods and tools aimed at guaranteeing maximum security and confidentiality, by subjects specifically appointed to do so. In compliance with the provisions of art. 5 paragraph 1 letter e) of Reg. UE 2016/679 the personal data collected will be stored in a form that allows identification of data subjects for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which the personal data are processed.

6. NATURE OF THE CONFERRALITY AND REFUSAL

7. RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED

You have the right, at any time, to ask the Data Controller to access your personal data, to rectify it, to cancel it or limit its processing. Without prejudice to any other administrative and judicial appeal, if you believe that the processing of data concerning you, violates the provisions of EU Reg. 2016/679, pursuant to art. 15 letter f) of the aforementioned EU Reg. 2016/679, you has the right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor for the protection of personal data and, with reference to art. 6 paragraph 1, letter a) and art. 9, paragraph 2, letter a), has the right to revoke the

consent given at any time.

In the case of requesting data portability, the Data Controller will provide you in a structured format, in common and legible, by automatic device, the personal data concerning you, without prejudice to paragraphs 3 and 4 of the art. 20 of the EU Reg. 2016/679.
